GOVERNORS' BEHAVIOUR STATEMENT

1. Positive behaviour is an essential foundation for a creative and effective learning and teaching environment.
2. The Behaviour for Learning Policy is a vehicle to support the learning culture allowing students and their families to develop a culture of positive and effective aspiration.
3. The Behaviour for Learning Policy focuses on developing students' motivation, independence and sense of personal responsibility for their own and others learning.
4. The Behaviour for Learning Policy contributes to ensuring Acton High School is a safe and supportive environment.
5. The Behaviour for Learning Policy provides a clear statement of the consistently high standards of positive behaviour expected in and out of the classroom. The Policy includes clear descriptions of the sanctions and rewards system and how they will be fairly and consistently applied, taking into account the needs of all school members as well as the local community.
6. The Behaviour for Learning Policy includes details of the interventions and support systems available both within the school and through external agencies.
7. The Behaviour for Learning Policy is clearly linked to the school's Antbullying and E-safety Policies.
8. The Behaviour for Learning Policy includes clear guidance on staff powers in respect of searching pupils, discipline outside school and the rarely occurring situations where use of reasonable force may be necessary for safety of pupils or staff.
9. The Behaviour for Learning Policy covers the management of allegations made against staff.
10. The Behaviour for Learning Policy is regularly reviewed, and views of pupils, parents, staff and governors are actively sought and taken into account.
11. The Behaviour for Learning Policy meets statutory requirements in relation to behaviour and exclusions and safeguarding.
