KS4 Subject Evening: Tuesday 24th January 2017

The next few weeks are a very important period in your child's education. They will shortly be choosing which subjects they would like to study in Years 10 and 11. The choices they make prepare them for further education, apprenticeships and work, and it is important that they are properly considered and discussed.

To help you and your child make the right decisions we are holding an Information Evening on Tuesday 24th January from 6.00pm until 7.30pm. It is important that you and your child attend. The evening will give you the chance to learn more about the courses on offer and see some of the resources that support learning and examples of the work students undertake. You will also have the opportunity to meet subject teachers and ask them questions about what their subjects entail.

In addition to the Information Evening, we will be running a drop-in session on Monday 30th January from 4:00pm to 5:30pm. This will provide an opportunity for you to have a one-to-one appointment with a member of the senior team so that individual concerns or questions that may have arisen since the Information Evening can be addressed.

Prior to the Information Evening, students will receive a subject information booklet which contains detailed information about the courses on offer at Key Stage 4. This will be a valuable resource for you to look through with your child so that you are familiar with the different types of courses available.

Following the evening, students will receive a Form on which they will complete their choices. This will need to be completed and returned to the school office by Friday 3rd February.
