YEARS 9 & 10 SPORTS DAY LETTER WEDNESDAY JULY 18th 2018

Dear Parent/Guardian,

On Wednesday, 18th July, the school will be holding our annual Sports Day at Osterley Sports & Athletics Centre (120 Wood Lane, Isleworth, TW7 5FF). The day will be run in a similar manner to last year with years 7 & 8 having their sports day in the morning and years 9 & 10 in the afternoon.

Years 9 and 10 students will be required to **be on site for 11am**. Students will go directly to their allocated room (this will be different from their normal form room) where registers and lunches will be organised. Students will **be escorted by their teachers to the athletics track between 11:45am and 1pm**. We will be travelling by public transport (tube) so any students who are late to school will risk missing their allotted travel slot. **School will not be open for the day so students need to be on time to travel with their allocated form group**. The school will provide tickets for travel so it will not cost anything for students to get to the event but they will need their Oyster Card if they have further travel requirements on the day. **The Sports Day will run from 1pm to 2:30pm**. Students will then be **escorted back to the school gates arriving between 3:15pm and 4pm** where they will be dismissed after a register is taken.

All students should wear **their black PE shorts/tracksuit and a plain (1 colour) t-shirt in their house colours** (Amethyst = purple, Diamond = white, Emerald = green, Onyx = black, Ruby = red). **If this is not possible they can wear their red AHS PE t-shirt**. Failure to do this may result in them not being able to take part on the day. **Phones are not allowed to be seen in school, while travelling or at the track as stated in our behaviour policy**.

Food will be available for all students to purchase from the school canteen from 9:00am and we would ask, where your child is not purchasing food that you provide a packed lunch from home. **Only water will be allowed in school, while travelling and at the track**. We also ask that they have suitable protection from the **elements i.e. sun cream/hat/umbrella etc. as appropriate**.

We would also like to take this opportunity to invite you to come along for the day to watch both your child and some of the other aspiring athletes that we have at Acton High School. If you would like to come along and watch we ask that you contact the school to receive a free ticket for the event and sign in on your arrival at the track. **No photos/videos or social media live streams are permitted at the track and anyone seen doing so will be asked to stop and delete the images or recordings**.

- **Years 9 & 10 arrive at school at 11am**
- **Bring PE kit/house colour t-shirt, water, lunch, money, cap, sun cream, umbrella, coat as appropriate**
- **Students need to collect their free school meal or bring a packed lunch.**
- **Students need to bring their inhalers and all other medicines etc. that are kept in school will be with the school nurse at the track.**
- **No fizzy drinks or phones as stated in our behaviour policy. Please freeze a large bottle of water for the day.**
- **Years 9 & 10 will be dismissed when they return to school between 3.15/4pm**

We do hope that you will be able to support this event, and we look forward to seeing you on the day.
