



Bromley High Art and Design Scholarship Information for Sixth Form Entry 2019

The Art Scholarship is awarded to a girl currently in Year 11 to assist her in the purchase of materials needed for her Advanced Level Art course at the school. Also, a % fee remission may be available.

This scholarship is awarded on both merit and the potential that a student shows in her enthusiasm; desire and ability to develop further her commitment to the subject in the future. Therefore, any student applying should certainly have decided to pursue Art/Photography and or Textiles at A level and possibly beyond.

The role of the Art Scholar is to act as an ambassador of the department and oversee the running of extra-curricular clubs in both the Junior and Senior School.

As part of the selection process, you will need to submit a letter of application outlining the reasons why you are applying. You may wish to consider the following:

What excites you about Art?

What do you most like about Art at Bromley High?

What qualities make a good Art scholar and how do you think these apply to you?

What are your personal strengths and weaknesses?

This letter of approximately **200 words** should be word processed and submitted together with a clearly labelled folder of **all** your Year 10 and 11 coursework to Mr Finnegan by Monday 5th November 2018.

The interviews will take place on 12th November 2018 with Mr Finnegan and an independent art specialist. This meeting will be informal (about 15 minutes in length) and will provide an opportunity to look at your practical coursework work with you and your reasons why you think you will make a good scholar!
