ALL criteria needs to be met to be awarded a grade 1 or 2, otherwise the grade below will be issued.

1. Outstanding

- a. Enthusiastic engagement in all learning. Asks questions that extend learning.
- b. Homework always completed on time and to a high standard.
- c. Actively seeks advice and feedback to improve the quality of own work.
- d. Is fully prepared for lessons with correct equipment and smart uniform. Behaves in a way that encourages outstanding learning.

2. Good

- a. Participates in learning tasks throughout the lesson. Asks questions to check learning.
- b. Completes homework to a good standard and meets most deadlines.
- c. Acts on advice and feedback to improve the quality of own work.
- d. Is fully prepared for lessons with correct equipment and smart uniform. Behaves in a way that supports learning.

3. Inconsistent

- a. Participates in learning activities, but may need prompting to remain on task.
- b. Completes most homework, but work may not match ability level or is often handed in late.
- c. Needs to be reminded about speed or quality of work and what has to be done to improve.
- d. Equipment and uniform does not always meet the required standard. Occasionally behaves in a way that does not support learning.

4. Below Expectations

- a. Shows a low level of engagement in lessons. Rarely asks questions related to learning.
- b. Regularly does not complete homework to an acceptable standard.
- c. Rarely acts on advice and feedback to improve quality of work.
- d. Regularly attends lessons without equipment and does not comply with uniform rules. Demonstrates behaviour that may reduce opportunities for learning.
