



Literacy & Numeracy Funding Report 2018-2019

Additional funding is allocated to schools to support year 7 students who did not meet the expected standard (100) in reading and / or maths at the end of Key Stage 2.

Felpham Community College use the funding to pay for:

- Additional staff in maths, English and SEN to enable smaller group, specialist teaching
- Early morning reading recovery programme
- Individual tuition and support as required in English & maths
- Accelerated reading programme

Allocated funding: £ 22,123

Measuring Impact

Year 7 Students (2017-20178 in receipt of the support available in literacy and numeracy have made on average 4 levels of progress in English and maths based on their current grade at the end of Year 7 against their baseline.

53/77, 69% of student are above their target level in English
30/76, 39%, of students are above their target level in maths

Our analysis shows that the support we have in place is building a stronger foundation for literacy and numeracy for these students. This is evidenced by the continued progress of the previous cohort
