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Dear Parent/Carer

We want to make sure Harlington is a bully free zone. We will not tolerate bullying at Harlington and want to involve all members of our community in achieving our aim.

Spring term sees the start of Harlington's Anti-bullying campaign and I wanted to take this opportunity to outline what we are doing and how you can be involved.

- The Anti-bullying group was established in December and is made up of students from a range of year groups. They are currently working with all form groups to establish a student friendly definition of bullying that all can understand;
- There will be a competition to design a logo and slogan for the campaign which will then appear on all our campaign materials;
- We will create an Anti-bullying charter in consultation with every parent, student and form group in the school;
- We have a group of anti-bullying mentors; they can offer one to one support to any victims of bullying. Students can be referred through their form tutor, House Leader or can self-refer by speaking with Student Support.
