- ✓ Students finalise personal statements
- ✓ References finalised by Form Tutors (once personal statements finished)
- ✓ UCAS applications completed online, checked and sent off before Christmas

- ✓ Interviews and places offered
- ✓ Final choices made for most students
- ✓ Select one firm choices and one insurance
- ✓ Register for finance
