Will they make true friends and find a boy-friend or will they be teased? Little do the twins realise that they will have to make a heart-wrench decision when one of them becomes sick.

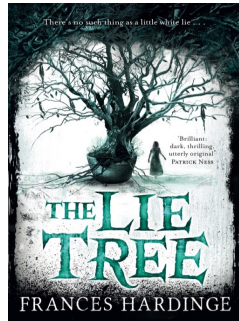
The CILIP Carnegie & Kate Greenaway Children's Book Awards

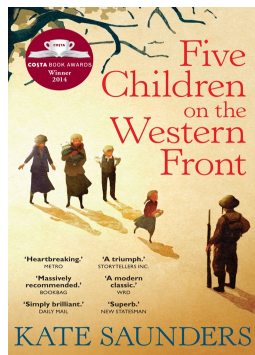

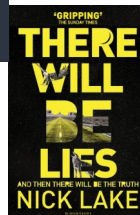

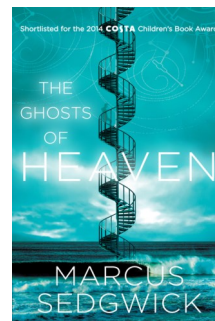
