

# Hazelwick School GCSE Results

## Summer 2018

Hazelwick students again produced outstanding GCSE results with Year 11 rising to the challenge of the new more difficult GCSE's. Our students achieved an excellent Progress 8 outcome, +0.44, maintaining Hazelwick's place as one of the top state schools, for GCSE outcomes, in the county.

In addition to the superb progress shown by our students, nearly one fifth achieved the new English Baccalaureate, based on the new tougher 9-5 measure across all the Baccalaureate subjects, compared to a figure of 19.5% achieved nationally the standard 9-4 measure. Combined with an impressive 20% of grades at 9-7 (A\*-A) level, including forty four students who achieved in excess of five grades at this level, we are very proud of our students' superb achievements, which is a fitting reward for the hard work and commitment shown.

Thirty one students achieved seven or more 9-7 (A\*-A), including an amazing nine perfect grades (9/A\*) by three students; Danyal Durrani, Sana Shah and Mira Szalma.
