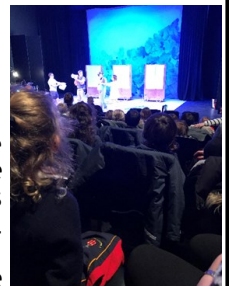

RECEPTION NEWS

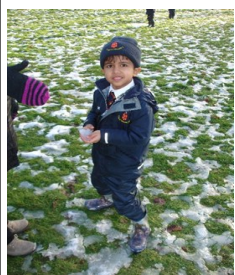
