Who are Sky Blues in the Community (SBitC)?

Based at the Ricoh Arena, SBitC is formerly a department of Coventry City Football Club formed in 1993 to deliver football in the community initiatives on behalf of the club. The organisation became a registered charity in December 2008, financially independent from the football club and governed by an independent Board of Trustees. Our team use the profile of the football club to engage with and improve the lives of children and adults within Coventry & Warwickshire.

Who are SBitC's after-school football clubs aimed at?

Everyone and anyone with an interest in sport or football: boys and girls of all abilities! SBitC football sessions offer a fun introduction to football as well as an ideal opportunity for those more experienced to develop their football skills, game understanding and confidence.

Why are SBitC good at what they do?

We've been delivering after-school football clubs for over 20 years and so are very experienced at knowing what works and what children enjoy doing! All of our experienced Lead Coaches are FA Qualified and hold up to date certificates in; Emergency First Aid and Safeguarding with a fully-checked DBS. Our coaches have experience of working in schools and ensure sessions cater for the needs of every child!

What can my child expect at an SBitC after-school football club?

We teach children how to effectively warm-up before coaching them through fun and structured football drills that are designed to be progressive and engaging; working and developing individually and also as part of a team. We promote key values such as; Respect, Resilience and Teamwork throughout, and always finish sessions with small-sided games or matches.

Are there any added benefits?

On completion of the course, each participant will receive a special SBitC prize and be invited to attend a Coventry City League Home Fixture at The Ricoh Arena during the 2017/18 season (1 adult & 1 child voucher) & other prizes.
