- Older pupils develop independence through the setting of the Senior School around the edge of the Cathedral Precinct
- Founded in 604 AD, King's is the second oldest school in the world and the oldest choir school. Our tradition and heritage support our vision for education in the 21st century
- Extensive sports facilities a short distance away – King's Rochester Sports Centre and The Alps playing fields
- 30 minutes from central London and easily accessible from the M2, A2, M20, M25 and M26



A DISTINCTIVE COMMUNITY BUILT ON CLEAR VALUES

- Close and friendly relationships between pupils and across age groups
- Strong rapport between pupils and staff who know each other well
- Parents are closely involved, not just in their children's education but in the wider life of the school through school events and The Friends
- A day school with a significant minority of boarders
- A diverse range of pupils and families. Some have lived in the area for generations, others have settled in Kent, some come to school each day from London and some have their homes overseas
- Moral values, self-discipline and emotional intelligence are central to our ethos




A DISTINCTIVE STRUCTURE

- A school that offers education from 3 to 18 in three schools
- Pre-Prep 3-8, Prep 8-13, Senior 13-18
- Each school focuses on the needs of particular age groups while having access to the facilities of a larger organisation
- Pupils and teachers overlap throughout all three schools enabling smooth transitions during their time at King's

A DISTINCTIVE VIEW OF EDUCATION

- Academic attainment at our core with a focus on developing skills, qualities and interests beyond the classroom
- Always seeking to produce better results than Grammar Schools and other independent schools but not to be an exam hothouse
- A wide range of sporting, artistic and cultural opportunities for all
