Conditions of Use

1. To book a place on any of the mini-bus routes please complete a request form and return it to the School Office at Lambrook School. Alternatively please send a written request.
2. Places on the mini-buses will be issued on a first come first served basis.
3. Parents should be aware that there is no additional supervision on the mini-buses.
4. Lambrook School cannot be responsible for the lateness or delay of the services.
5. In the mornings children should arrive at their stop 5 minutes prior to the timetabled arrive time. Mini-buses will leave the stop at the allotted time.
6. If a mini-bus arrives early at a stop it is required to wait until the timetabled time before it continues.
7. School mini-buses have seat belts. It is a condition of use that students use the seatbelts throughout the journey. Failure to adhere to this requirement will lead to withdrawal from the service.
