

# Senior School

## (YEAR 7 TO YEAR 11)

*Updated November 2016 for action from September 2017*

Girls are ambassadors for the school and their uniform should be correct and smart at all times.

Throughout the uniform list there are no recommended numbers for each item. Parents are free to purchase the number to suit their own laundry/boarding arrangements. Do remember that the PTAs run a second-hand shop where many of these items may also be purchased.

All items are available from the School shop unless marked with an asterisk\*.

Please note that washing instructions for some of the kit and uniform needs to be followed carefully as the use of fabric softeners adversely affects the waterproofing.

### Labelling

All items must be named. For ease of returning lost property it would aid us greatly if clothing is named in the following way:

**Senior School** - name tags should be purchased with font in the same colour as your daughter's house. These labels can be ordered through the School Shop and should be ½ inch in size. All other items brought into school, including iPads, phones, watches etc. should be clearly labelled or engraved where appropriate. If possible include at the end of the label your daughter's house, i.e. AS, ME, MI, MU, RB or ST.

You may **also** wish to write your daughter's name on the inside of the garment itself using a permanent marker just in case the name label should become detached from the garment.

### iPads

iPads are a compulsory item for girls in UII to Upper 5. We have chosen the latest iPad Air 2 64GB Wi-Fi only, as the minimum suggested specification. The 64GB version or higher is recommended to ensure that the iPad will comfortably handle two years use and the weight of materials we expect the girls to store: educational film clips, e-books, photographs etc. If you purchase your own iPad separately, we ask that it be a Wi-Fi only and not a 3G/4G device. Our internet filter protection for our students, and restricted access to social media sites, can only be applied to Wi-Fi devices.

Please do not use fabric conditioner or tumble dry. No ironing.
Squad team hat	For girls in the swim squad. Can be labelled with laundry marker or permanent pen.
t-bag over swim suit	Use at swimming galas. Named on the inside of the collar.
Fleece	All the senior girls can wear fleece to and from school on top of their blazers. <b>Only girls from U4 and above can wear fleeces around the school, but only in winter time and on top of their jumpers - in exceptionally cold weather and when advised by staff.</b> Named on the inside of the collar. Washing at 30°.
Waterproof tracksuit jacket and trousers	Named on the inside of the waistband at the back (trousers) and on the inside of the collar (jacket). Washing at 30° and inside out. Please do not use fabric conditioner or tumble dry. No ironing.

## Boarders

### COMPULSORY – must be named.

- Smart fleece or coat suitable for the season
- Leisure wear or casual wear e.g. skirts and jeans etc., blouses and sweaters
- A smart outfit for Church on Sundays (jeans not permitted for church)
- Underwear and tights
- 2 pairs of pyjamas or night dresses
- Dressing gown
- Slippers or flip flops
- Sponge bag containing toiletries
- 1 duvet (duvet cover and pillowcases optional)
- Needlework kit with mending materials and an extra supply of name tapes
- Weekend bag
- Rug or blanket (optional)

**Sixth Form** do not wear uniform, but are expected to observe a respectable dress code as set down in the Sixth Form Handbook.

Sixth Form girls should have access to a smart two-piece or three-piece suit, (jacket and matching skirt/trousers) in a plain dark colour. This will be worn on all formal occasions, including the first day of term and Long Parliament at the end of term and on other occasions as stated in the Sixth Form Handbook. They will also need a pair of sensible, dark-coloured court or flat shoes, although colourful shoes may be worn with the suit on certain occasions. Girls taking part in musical performances must wear their suit skirt/trousers and a white shirt.

**Hair** must be worn off the face. Navy hairbands/clips can be purchased at the school shop. Exaggerated styles and colours are not allowed.

**Jewellery** allowed with school uniform is a watch, a plain cross and chain, plain stud earrings or sleepers (one per ear lobe only) and any Medicare item. We recommend that any initial or additional piercing, with parental permission, should only be done at the start of the summer holiday so that proper healing can take place before the start of term.

### The School Shop

School uniform has to be obtained from the School Shop on site at St. Catherine's School. It is situated in the Business Centre and can be accessed via a path to the left of the Business Centre building. The School Shop is open on Tuesdays between 8.30am to 2pm and on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays between 1pm to 4.50pm, during term time. It is not open during Autumn, Spring and Summer half term.

If you are buying a large number of items or having a complete fit out you should contact School Shop to arrange appointment. This is especially important for all new girls.

The School Shop will be open from 9.30am till 12.30pm and 1pm to 4.30pm from 14<sup>th</sup> of July to 31<sup>st</sup> of August for pre-arranged appointments ONLY. Appointments can be booked via email on [school.shop@stcatherines.info](mailto:school.shop@stcatherines.info) or on the phone 01483 899709. From 1<sup>st</sup> of September onwards Shop will be open from 9.30am to 4.30pm for general sales and appointments.

The shop accepts cash, credit/debit cards and cheques (payable to St. Catherine's Enterprises). Payments can also be made over the phone to 01483 899709.

Only boarders can have uniform costs added to their bills and then only with the approval of their Boarding Housemistress.

### The Prep School PTA Second Hand Shop

The Prep School PTA open the shop on Tuesday mornings from 8.30 to 9.30 a.m., Friday afternoons from 2.30 to 3.30 p.m. during term time, and from 10am to 1pm the day before each term starts. It is open on the following days in the summer holidays.

We can open outside these times, both during term and school holidays, upon request. Make contact if you need a special opening to suit your schedule and we will do our best to accommodate you.

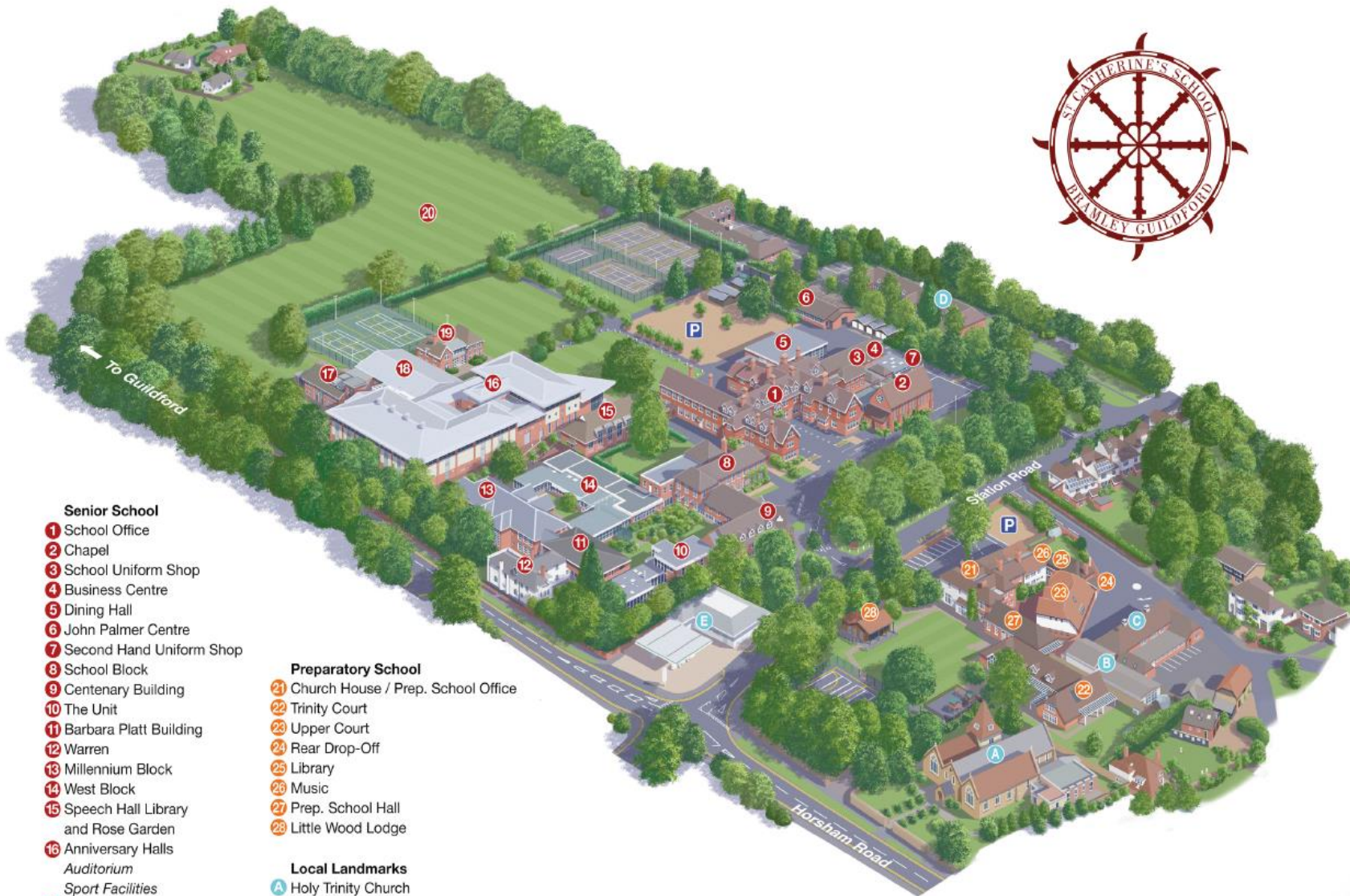
