<p><b><u>SUMMARY OF AWARDS &amp; SCHOLARSHIP</u></b></p> <p><b>Instrumental Award 1:</b> to encourage girls at 11+ to take up less familiar instruments, e.g. Viola, Double Bass, Bassoon, French Horn, Trombone, Tuba, Euphonium &amp; Oboe.</p> <p><b>Instrumental Award 2:</b> is intended for girls who have been learning an orchestral or band instrument (not voice, piano or organ) for a relatively short period of time, and who have already made considerable progress.</p> <p><b>Organ Award:</b> to encourage girls to learn the organ. Candidates should already be competent pianists.</p> <p><b>11+ Music Scholarship:</b> is awarded to a girl who demonstrates not only a good standard already reached in an instrument/voice (approximately Grade 5 is a reasonable expectation), but also high potential and lively interest, both in her instrument and in music generally. Ability in a second instrument/voice would also be an advantage. The holder would be expected to take a full and active part in School music, and it is expected that she would choose Music as an option for GCSE and A Level in due course.</p>
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
