English	Goodnight Mr Tom by Michelle Magorian Grammar: relative clauses, forms of parenthesis, apostrophes, spelling, proofreading and editing. Descriptive writing from a picture. Creative writing and planning techniques. Letter, leaflet writing and diary entries. 11+ type comprehensions
Maths	5XS & 5XT Revision of all topics, Fractions, algebra, area and volume, equations, negative numbers, co-ordinates, graphs, angles, handling data, percentages, averages, transformations, calculator skills, multiplying and division, methods. Set 5XG Neg. numbers, multiplication, addition, subtraction, division, capacity angles, fractions / decimals, percentages, square numbers, factors.
Science	Adaptations and habitats Chemical changes Forces
Geography	Map skills. Revision of all topics. Compass directions. Scales. Ordnance Survey maps.
History	Events of World War Two - including evacuation of Dunkirk The Blitz. D-Day Landings. The Home Front.
Music	Investigating compound time; time signatures using minims; further recognition of notes; syncopation; learning to phrase. Preparation for end of term concert.
Religious Education	Study of Judaism: Looking at individual Jewish festivals, Kosher food and Orthodox Jews. An overview of Sikhism and Hinduism
Computing	Typing and E Safety
PSHCE	Pupil Council SEAL link: Chancing your Luck CITIZENSHIP: Human rights / Judging by appearances ECONOMIC: Rich World, Poor World
French	Tricolore Total 1: Places in Town, Time, At the Tourist Office, Likes and dislikes of school subjects, Directions, School Life in France, A typical day, School timetable
Latin	1st and 2nd declension nouns in the nominative and accusative cases, singular and plural. Revision of all vocabulary and endings taught thus far. Greek and Roman Gods and assorted myths.
DT	Design and make a sweet dispenser, using natural and man-made woods and acrylic plastic
Art	Drawing with oil pastels. Food theme. Painting. Lino printing. Mixed media. Group artwork.
PE	Athletics: pupils taught the correct technique for each event and assessed in line with the STG award scheme. Track events: sprints, hurdles, distance, relays. Field events: high jump, long jump, ball throw.
Boys' Games	CRICKET: Team selection (Colts A,B,C & Development). Fielding skills. Bowling technique. Batting. Fielding positions. Running between wickets / communication. Hard ball for A, B and later, C. Incred-ball Development teams - timed / limited over game. Tennis and softball will also be played on occasions.
Girls' Games	ROUNDERS: Throwing - underarm, overarm, distance. Catching - moving to the side. Bowling – with accuracy and speed. Fielding - responding to oppositional play. Hitting - striking for accuracy. Developing an understanding of match play and rules.
