Introduction:

Most of the year, Year 4 have one spelling lesson, one grammar lesson, one punctuation lesson and two literature/writing lessons. There is also a library session once a week.

Year 4 have one homework a week. This will usually be a written task. In addition, there is a spelling test to revise for each week.

Key objectives

- To improve their spelling through regular exercises and short tests
- Revision of spelling rules learnt in Year 3 and learning new ones

- To continue to develop writing skills that focus particularly on description and information texts
- Poetry by Heart
- Comprehension Exercises
