Introduction:

The geography curriculum is a spiral curriculum in which the boys will revisit topics and build on their knowledge and understanding of various geographical topics.

Key Objectives:

- Improving knowledge of the human and physical features of the G7 countries
- Understanding why settlements arise in particular locations
- Knowing and identifying settlement patterns on maps and aerial photographs
- Knowing and understanding why early settlements grew into cities
- Understanding what attracts tourists to various destinations
- Identifying the location of various tourist destinations on maps and in atlases
- Collecting information on tourism using an interview survey
- Representing data from a survey in a graph
- Investigating the food, language, currency, human and physical features of various popular tourist destinations
- Revision of Year 4 work

Resources:

All boys must bring the following equipment to all lessons:

Handwriting pen (blue), Pencil, Rubber, Pencil Sharpener, 30cm Ruler, Colouring Pencils, Highlighter Pens, Glue Stick.
