Geography – Summer Term

Year 5

Introduction:

The geography curriculum is a spiral curriculum in which the boys will revisit topics and build on their knowledge and understanding of various geographical topics.

Key Objectives:

- Know the location of the world's major river systems
- Know the location of the world's oceans and major seas
- Know what is meant by the terms latitude and longitude, and identify the main lines of latitude and longitude.
- Revise the use of 4-figure references on OS maps
- Use cardinal directions to 8 points on OS maps
- Interpret OS maps accurately using symbols and keys
- Understand how London has changed over time
- Case study of urban renewal in London: East Village, Olympic Park
- Use maps to identify major landmarks in London
- Revision of Year 5 work

Resources:

All boys must bring the following equipment to all lessons:

Handwriting pen (blue), Pencil, Rubber, Pencil Sharpener, 30cm Ruler, Colouring Pencils, Highlighter Pens, Glue Stick.
