Re: Geography trip to Iceland, 20 – 24 July 2015

The Geography department is offering students a fantastic opportunity to visit Iceland next summer, on the dates shown above. This will be a 5 day / 4 night trip and will give students a chance to experience a truly unique country. Students will study a range of tectonic processes which will aid their understanding of the causes, effects and responses to natural hazards. The cost of the trip is **£780**, and a sample of the itinerary includes:

- Return flights to Iceland
- 2 nights half board accommodation at Hotel Cabin in Reykjavik
- 2 nights half board accommodation at Hotel Ork in Hyerageroi (with its own outdoor heated swimming pool). Students will have time to explore the geothermal park and experience an earthquake simulator
- A trip to the Blue Lagoon and a swim in the geothermal waters (entrance fee included)
- A day trip along the 'South Shore' which includes visits to the 'Eyjafjallajökull Erupts!' exhibition and film, Seljalandsfoss (a waterfall that you can walk behind) and a visit to the black beaches at Vik
- A full day excursion around the famous 'Golden Circle', which includes visits to Geysir geothermal area, Gullfoss waterfall and Pingvellir National Park
- A 2 hour glacier walk on the breath-taking Sólheimajökull glacier (lead by experienced guides)

If you would like you son/daughter to take part on this trip then please complete and return the slip below, together with a deposit of £150 (cheques made payable to Tupton Hall School) to either their Geography teacher or myself, by Friday 17 October 2014. Places are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
