

## For Admission to University September 2019

Depending on which university you apply to and which course you wish to study, you may need to take an admissions test as part of your application. You are strongly advised to check the relevant university's website for the most up-to-date information about their entry requirements.

You should also look at the Admissions Testing Service website for information on admissions tests, including which courses require you to take tests, how to register, when the tests are and how to get your results:

## STEP 2019 - details To Be Advised

### Registration Process

Students **MUST** register through the Exams Officer, Miss Clode, by picking up a registration form from the Exams/Data/Admissions Office between 1<sup>st</sup> September and 12<sup>th</sup> October to ensure timely registration.

Students taking BMAT and Test of Mathematics **MUST** pay the registration fee on Parent Pay **BEFORE** completing the form and returning it to Miss Clode, together with proof of payment. Paying for the test does not register you for the test – you **MUST** still complete a registration form.

Fee information will be released on 1<sup>st</sup> September.

When Miss Clode has registered you for a test, you will be sent an e-mail with your registration number in it. You should contact Miss Clode immediately if you have not received an e-mail within 24 hours of handing in your form. This is proof you have been registered.

No late entries can be accepted whatever the reason.

**NB** Please bear in mind that the school's registration deadlines may be earlier than these in order to process payments before entries can be made. Make sure you complete the application form in good time. If in doubt please ask the Exams Officer
