Discounts

Services and FCO Families

Any current serving member of the Armed Forces or Foreign and Commonwealth Office personnel whose daughter weekly or full boards will qualify for a 10% discount.

Sibling Discounts

For those families with more than one child in the school at the same time there will be the following discounts on both tuition and boarding fees:

For the second child in school – 5%

For the third child in school – 10%

The sibling discount will not apply to those in receipt of Governors' Exhibitions, Bursaries, Head of Prep's Bursary Awards, Services Boarding discounts or Staff discounts. For those in receipt of Scholarships the discount will be applied to the parental contribution.

Early Years Entitlement

All three year olds are entitled to access the Universal Early Years Entitlement for up to six funding periods before they reach statutory school age. Children become eligible for funding in the term following their third birthday and this continues until the term in which they are five (into Reception Year). The current maximum entitlement is for 15 hours per week which is claimed from Somerset County Council (SCC). The school charges SCC agreed additional services.

Extended Early Years Entitlement (30 hours) is available in the pre-school only. Parents need to meet the eligibility criteria.

Fees and extras are charged and payable in accordance with the school's Standard Terms and Conditions [ST&C], a copy of which can be obtained from the Bursar.
